

On Palm Sunday Christians celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem, the week before his death and resurrection. Palm Sunday, often referred to as "Passion Sunday," marks the beginning of Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday. Join us for Sunday school at 9:00 am and Worship at 10:30 am. "MAUNDY THURSDAY," also known as Holy Thursday, is the anniversary day of Jesus' institution of his Last Supper in the upper room in Jerusalem, the eve before his crucifixion. The word 'maundy' comes from the Latin word 'mandatum,' which means 'to command.' It refers to the command Jesus gave to his disciples that evening as recorded in John 13:34, "And now I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." Please join us for this special service at 7:00 pm in the Sanctuary. Good Friday is observed on the Friday before Easter Sunday. On this day Christians commemorate the passion, or suffering, and death on the cross of the Lord, Jesus Christ. You are invited to engage in a time of prayer and reflection in Lapsley Chapel from noon until 3:00 pm. On Easter Sunday, Christians celebrate the resurrection of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Join us for Sunday school at 9:00 am and Worship at 10:30 am. Join us in the fellowship hall on Feb. 5 at 6pm for dinner with programming for adults at 6:40 and we will be finished by 7:30.
