Dear Church Family -

Thank you again for your prayers as we continue the work of finding our next Senior Pastor. As you know, we first posted the open position on the EPC's website in January as well as other sources. We have been very encouraged that 15 individuals to date have expressed interest in FEPC. Each submission has been carefully reviewed, and, in some cases initial interviews were scheduled

At the present time, we are speaking with a serious candidate who has also expressed interest in serving FEPC. We are working through the process of interviews, calling references and scheduling face-to-face meetings over the coming weeks. We cannot provide more details at this time due to the confidential nature of the search, as he has not notified his current church of his interest in FEPC. We are encouraged thus far, and are asking for prayer for discernment, wisdom and patience for both the candidate and the Search Committee as we work through this process. More details will be provided when appropriate.

The search process includes working closely with the Ministerial Committee of the New River Presbytery as they will need to accept into the Presbytery any candidate we choose to call to our pulpit.

Please keep praying for the candidate God has chosen for FEPC, the search committee, the Presbytery's Ministerial Committee and all of the candidates we have been in contact with us as they seek their next call.
