The Season of Lent

During the Christian Year, the season of Lent is a time when we focus on simple living, prayer, and fasting in order to expand our relationship with God. Ash Wednesday begins the season of Lent and Easter concludes it.

Palm/Passion Sunday April 14

On Palm Sunday Christians celebrate the triumphal entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem, the week before his death and resurrection. Palm Sunday, often referred to as "Passion Sunday," marks the beginning of Holy Week, which concludes on Easter Sunday. Join us for Sunday school at 9:00 am and Worship at 10:30 am.

Maundy Thursday April 18, 7:00 pm

"MAUNDY THURSDAY," also known as Holy Thursday, is the anniversary day of Jesus' institution of his Last Supper in the upper room in Jerusalem, the eve before his crucifixion. The word 'maundy' comes from the Latin word 'mandatum,' which means 'to command.' It refers to the command Jesus gave to his disciples that evening as recorded in John 13:34, "And now I give you a new commandment: love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." Please join us for this special service at 7:00 pm in the Sanctuary.

Good Friday April 19

Good Friday is observed on the Friday before Easter Sunday. On this day Christians commemorate the passion, or suffering, and death on the cross of the Lord, Jesus Christ. You are invited to engage in a time of prayer and reflection in Lapsley Chapel from noon until 3:00 pm.

Easter Sunday April 21

On Easter Sunday, Christians celebrate the resurrection of the Lord, Jesus Christ. Join us for Sunday school at 9:00 am and Worship at 10:30 am.
